Dear colleagues,

I express my profound respect on behalf of the Sirius Federal Territory and the organizing committee of the 22d International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO — 2025) and have the honor to invite you to participate in the IJSO-2025 Olympiad, which will be held from November 23 to December 2, 2025, at Sirius, the Russian Federation.

IJSO is an international competition in natural sciences aimed at engaging schoolchildren in studying and addressing current scientific challenges, enhancing the ability to apply theoretical concepts to real-world scenarios, as well as strengthening international cooperation and exchanging experience among participants.

The Olympiad is organized by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, the Talent and Success Educational Foundation and Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology, with the support of the Government of the Russian Federation.

On behalf of the Sirius Federal Territory and the Organizing Committee, we would like to assure you that the safety and well-being of our guests and participants are our utmost priority. Sirius maintains a calm and stable environment, with all educational, professional, and recreational activities proceeding as usual.

To offer additional reassurance for parents and guardians, the organizing committee is ready to provide both civil liability and health insurance for all guests and participants of the IJSO — 2025.

Each team can be composed of a maximum of six students and three leaders. All students must comply with the IJSO statutes and be 15 years old or younger on 31 December, 2025.

The working language of IJSO — 2025 is English. The Olympiad consists of three rounds — an experimental round, a theoretical round, and a multiple-choice questionnaire — held on different days. Not only can participants expect interesting Olympiad tasks, but they can also make the most of an extensive cultural agenda with lectures, master classes and excursions.

November 30 — Moderation Session

December 1 — Closing Ceremony and Gala Dinner

December 2 — Departure

The sending party bears responsibility for all travel expenses to and from the host country, including visa costs. The organizer will provide comprehensive support including airport transfers, local transportation throughout the event, accommodation, meals, and a cultural program from November 23 to December 2. Should participants require early arrival before November 23 or late departure after December 2 due to limited travel options, the organizer will extend the provision of transfers, accommodation, and meals for up to one additional night before and/or after the official dates.


The organizational fee is 1,000 USD per team. Observer participation is funded separately through the observer fee of 150,000 RUB. Should the leaders or observers require a single room, the rate is 61,200 RUB.

To participate in the Olympiad, registration on the official Olympiad website <https://ijso.siriusolymp.ru/> is required. The registration deadline will be published on the Olympiad website and in the coming Circulars.

The competition rounds will be held at the Sirius Arena (2, Startovaya Street, Sirius federal territory, Russian Federation). The accommodation of the participants will be arranged at the campus of the Sirius Educational Center (40, Olimpiyskiy Prospect, Sirius federal territory, Russian Federation).

Team leaders and observers will be accommodated at the Alpha Sirius Hotel (1, Morskoy Boulevard, Sirius federal territory, Russian Federation).
